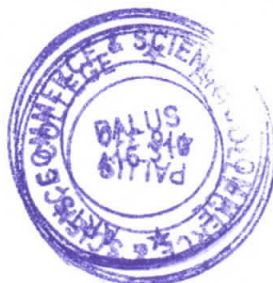
Courses Offered:
